Travel to Wageningen

By plane

Nearest/best connected airport is Amsterdam-Schiphol (AMS): travel to Ede-Wageningen station ca. 1h

Alternatively Eindhoven (EIN): travel to Ede-Wageningen station ca. 1.5h

By train

Wageningen does not have a train station. Ede-Wageningen is closest. From Ede- Wageningen direct connections to Amsterdam (EuroStar) and Utrecht (connection to Frankfurt/Main).

Bus line 88 or 84 (no cash accepted, only card)

Taxis at the station

Suggestion 2: If you plan to use public transport a lot, you can buy an OV-chipcard for 7€ at the machines of NS (at train stations). This can be loaded with credit and used in all public transport.

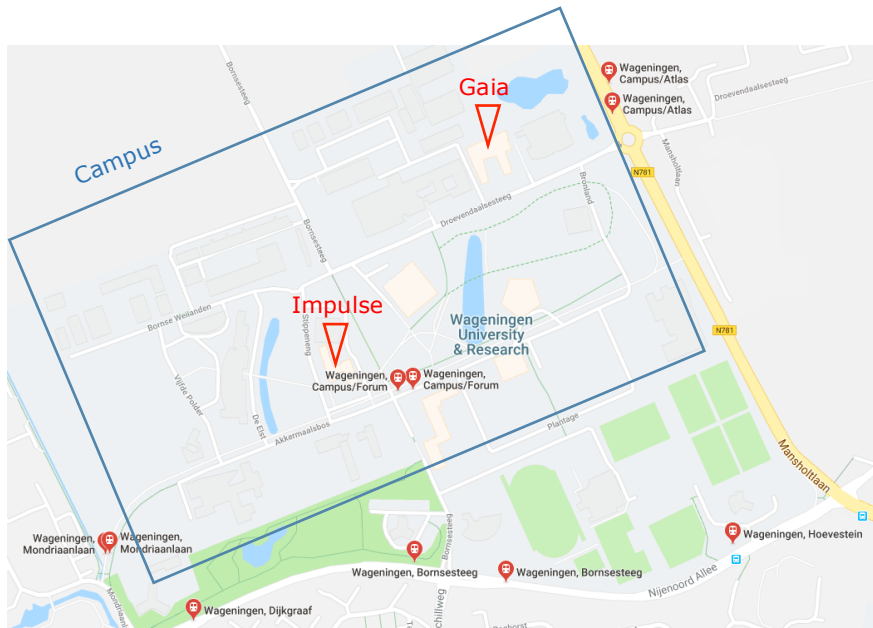
